- to train trainers and improve the capacity and competence of trainers,
- to establish an e-platform providing online training and ensuring visibility,
- to ensure that employers and job seekers meet on the platform database,
- to provide online training to increase M/R capacities,
- to ensure that M/Rs contribute to the agricultural and economic development of the host countries,
- preparation of a guidebook regarding the agricultural sector,
- to increase M/Rs' awareness of the need to protect natural resources and the environment in agricultural production in training sessions.
