CAMRAS Learning, Teaching and Training Activities Meeting

From the 21th to the 23th of August 2024, AMSED hosted the CAMRAS LTTA in Strasbourg, France.

The event provided an invaluable platform for participants to exchange knowledge, refine strategies, and explore innovative approaches to integrating migrants and refugees into the agricultural sector.











Here are the main outcomes of the LTTA :

Training Sessions: 6 training modules were delivered

Six training modules were delivered, covering key areas such as migrants and refugees employability in the agricultural sector, EU tools and qualification frameworks for integration, skills assessment for improved working conditions, and post-placement support for sustainable employment. Best practices in migrants and refugees integration were shared, alongside modules on uploading/downloading curriculum materials and applying non-formal teaching methods in agriculture.

Field Visit: Les Jardins de la Montagne Verte

The visit to the association "Les Jardins de la Montagne Verte" showcased their integration efforts in employing 150 individuals, including 70-80% migrants or refugees, in various domains like market gardening, carpentry, and cooking. The association focuses on organic farming and biodiversity, with its main goal being the social and professional integration of its employees, rather than profit. GIE GENIUS, a partner, provides post-placement support and manages recruitment across several sectors, offering short-term integration contracts to help individuals transition into the professional world. The visit provided valuable insights for the CAMRAS Project partners to be considered when organizing face-to-face training and addressing integration challenges.
