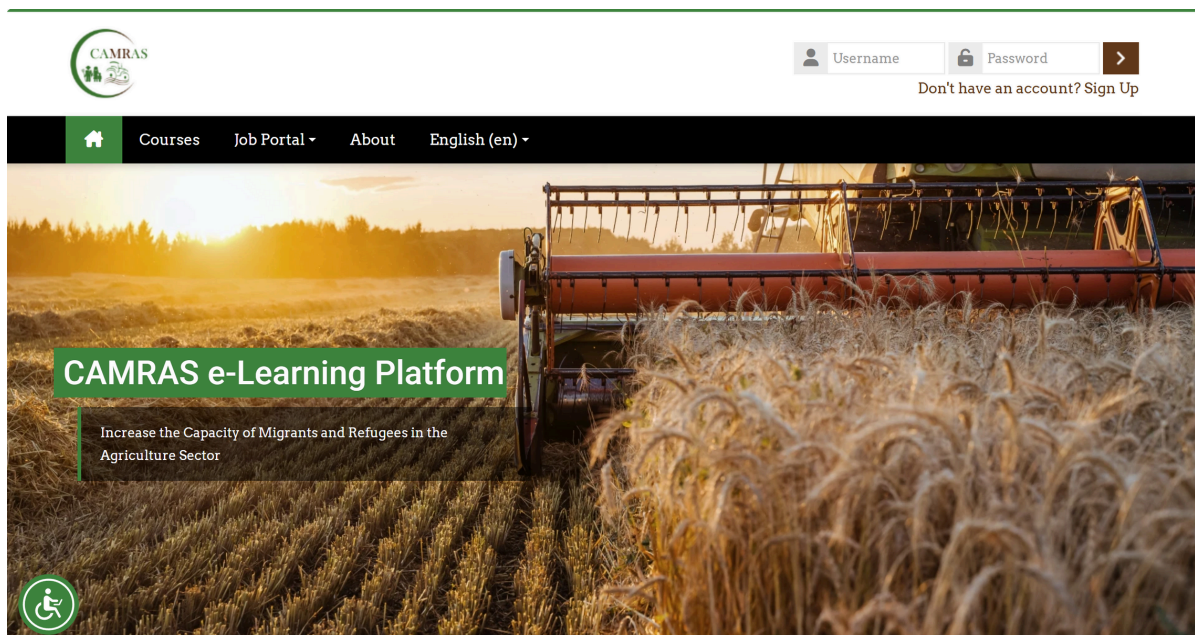
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What is the CAMRAS e-learning platform?

The CAMRAS e-learning platform is a cornerstone of the project, designed to empower migrants and refugees with the skills needed to pursue careers in agriculture. The platform offers a rich and user-friendly learning experience, featuring a comprehensive course made up of seven modules: Agriculture & Life, Crop Production, Animal Breeding, Innovations in Agricultural Production, Sustainable Agriculture, Worker Skills & Labour Issues, and Problems of the Agricultural Sector, all. Each module includes a mix of videos, interactive content, and assessments to support effective learning. Beyond training, the platform also acts as an information hub and matchmaking tool, linking aspiring agricultural workers with farmers across the CAMRAS partner countries.



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Training in Türkiye, Spain, France, and the Netherlands

Face-to-face and online training sessions were successfully implemented in Türkiye, Spain, France, and the Netherlands, each with its unique set of challenges and cultural contexts. In each country, local organizations worked closely with the CAMRAS team to ensure that the training met the specific needs of the migrant and refugee populations. These international events showcased the adaptability of the CAMRAS platform and provided essential insights into the digital literacy challenges faced by migrant communities across different regions.

Participants in these countries, like their counterparts in Spain, shared similar struggles with digital skills, language barriers, and accessing formal training. However, through a combination of in-person support and guided online sessions, they were able to navigate the CAMRAS platform and complete their training successfully. The positive feedback from participants across these diverse countries highlighted the universal value of the CAMRAS project in empowering migrant and refugee communities.
